

Navient raises \$19,000 during second Ladders & Laces 5K and Jeans BeCause program to support Hanover Township Fire Department

In addition to the 5K, employees raised funds to support the local firehouse through Navient's popular Jeans BeCause program. The program allows participating employees a "pass" to dress casually for the month in exchange for volunteer donations.
